There is a free number on the university campus that you can call if you have just been sexually assaulted.

Call Alice!

If you call this number, a taxi from the company 'Taxis Verts' will come for you, and only you, and take you to a centre SAC (Sexual Assault Centre).

There, you will be able to speak to a forensic nurse, rest, wash up and talk to a person of trust.

The medical team will take care of you in a gentle, caring and non-judgmental manner.

Once you are there, you are free to contact the police or not.

The samples taken on site will be kept for 6 months. This gives you time to decide, even weeks later, whether or not you want to file a complaint to the police.

Psychological support is offered even up to several weeks after the event.

This centre guarantees anonymity and is completely free (both transport by taxi and treatment at the centre).

Note: the taxi driver on duty is someone trained for this kind of ride.

When you call this number, the driver will be informed of the reason for the call.

So you don't have to explain what just happened.

He knows he has to take you to the centre safely.

He will accompany you to the door of the SAC to give you as much support as possible in this situation.

In case of emergency, you can always call 112 or 02 788 53 43.

Do not hesitate to save this number in your contacts and to tell people around you about it.
